- 3. We are generously supported by: Cycle Therapy, Frontrunners, and Wilderness Kayaking, and many small businesses in our community. In turn, we have chosen to support KidSports BC with a portion of your entry fee.
- 4. Please print off any course maps you might need before arriving. In an effort to save paper we will not be providing them in each race package.
- 5. The adhesive bicycle seat post number must be attached to your bike with the number visible from both sides, before entering transition. Take your running race number with you to the body marking station to ensure that you are marked correctly. You will not be able to remove your bike from transition if these numbers do not match.
